## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Quality believes in bringing optimism and happiness to the lives of children and their families affected by cancer through fun therapy. We believe that laughter is the best medicine.

| 1. Volunteers are required to follow the instructions of Camp Quality staff or their appointed representatives at all times  |
| 2. Permission must be gained from the PCO (puppet coordinator) before anyone is brought to a performance   |
| 3. Any questions from teachers or students about cancer must be referred to the PCO  |
| 4. Volunteers are not permitted to talk to the media in any official capacity. All media requests are to be directed to the PCO  |
| 5. All volunteers are to be sensitive to the individual beliefs and cultures of others   |
| 6. No volunteer is to promote or be critical of any medicine (conventional or alternate) or health food diets  |
| 7. No volunteer is to promote or be critical of any religious denomination during participation in the puppet program  |
| 8. Inappropriate language is prohibited at all Camp Quality events   |
| 9. Puppeteers must arrive at venue/meeting place at least 15 minutes prior to scheduled time and contact PCO immediately if they are running late  |
| 10. Puppets are to be used for the sole purpose of the MCQP program and only by authorised puppeteers  |
| 11. The use of tobacco or illegal drugs at any MCQP booking or while in uniform is prohibited. Consumption or service of alcohol is only permitted with the consent of the PCO and must be carried out in a responsible manner   |
| 12. All volunteer uniforms and name badges must be returned when a puppeteer ceases to participate in MCQP program   |
| 13. Australian legislation does not permit Camp Quality Limited's Voluntary Worker's Insurance to include coverage for medical expenses for volunteers   |
| 14. All personal equipment is entirely the responsibility of the owner. Camp Quality accepts no responsibility for the health and safety or personal property of volunteers. Volunteers may not make a claim on Camp Quality or any of its staff or officers for any injury, ill health, loss or damage to their personal property, unless caused by negligence and must agree to release Camp Quality from all obligations arising in law from such loss or damage. |
| <b>These guidelines serve to protect the privacy and safety of puppeteer volunteers and the general public. At all times, volunteers must be aware not only of their own actions, but also how their actions may appear to observers.</b>  |
