Who Leads this Optimistic Bunch?


At Camp Quality we lead from the ground up to create an optimistic community for our families through fun therapy and education.


Forming a solid foundation our **Board of Directors** is a dedicated team responsible for the governance of the organisation. Their focus is to ensure the organisation is properly managed and remains true to its charter.

The primary objective of the **Leadership Team** is to lead, monitor, review and report on the organisation strategic goals and objectives. Led by the CEO  the team of six comprises of the General Manager, National Finance, Business,  Human Resource and Marketing Managers.  Each manager also leads their respective functional teams.

The **Senior Operations Team**, reporting to the General Manager, holds responsibility for our local operations across the country and importantly our program delivery. Spread across Australia the team is made up of three Regional Managers and the Performance and Education Manager.

To reinforce our 'one team' focus the Leadership and Senior Operations Teams meet quarterly, providing a forum for open communication and problem solving. Together they are referred to as the **Senior Management Team**.

Reporting to one of three Regional Managers, the **Area Manager Team**  of 12, spread throughout Australia, lead their local team in the delivery of programs and services to children living with cancer, and the raising of funds, profile and community engagement. Staff from the local team make up both the **Program and Fundraising Teams**.

The Performance & Education Team led by the Performance and Education Manager  is responsible for both the Primary and High School Education Program and the operation of Giggle, part of the Hospital Program.
