We support children 0-15 years of age diagnosed with cancer, as well as their siblings, parents and carers.

We also support children 0-15 years facing the cancer diagnosis of a parent or carer. (KICC: Kids Impacted by a Carer's Cancer.)

Camp Quality's services and programs provide laughter, distraction and specialised cancer care to children in hospital, and offer families fun experiences to reconnect, create positive memories, and build a supportive community. Our school cancer education program dispels myths to prevent bullying, and our fun digital programs are there for children whenever and wherever they need us. We remain by a family's side through the toughest parts of the cancer experience, such as palliative care and bereavement.

The wellbeing of parents is crucial, and our online support platform and counselling service is available to parents impacted by cancer across Australia.

From diagnosis, Camp Quality is there for kids and their families.

Camp Quality Puppet Playdates are visits from the Camp Quality Puppets. These cheeky, lovable puppets bring fun and distraction to children at their hospital bedsides, boosting their wellbeing and making them laugh, no matter how sick they feel.

Child Life Therapists are sponsored by Camp Quality in NSW and Victorian children's hospitals.* These health professionals provide play therapy sessions to children undergoing cancer treatment. They teach coping techniques that reduce a child's anxiety about the procedures they face, decreasing stress and the need for sedation.

Kids' Camps* give children aged four and over the fun times that childhood should be all about: new friends, adventures and experiences filled with laughter and positivity. Family Camps give Camp Quality families time to reconnect and share the ongoing experiences they face with other families. Volunteers give parents the chance to relax - often for the first time since a child's diagnosis.




VOLUNTEERING

Volunteering is a rewarding experience and many have been with Camp Quality for years, even decades.



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
